Material Used: Heavy Charred ThermoWood Ash Hardwood.

'Hit and Miss' Fin Style Cladding

A classic mid – terraced property in a fashionable part of west London provided an opportunity to do something different. Using the sustainably sourced and produced Thermowood Ash meant that by heavy charring the surface, it provided a UV resistant 'Snake Skin' surface texture that will not fade or require on going maintenance.

This material due to its stability and fire rating also allowed us to create a fin style look for the rear ground floor and first floor extension with a full refurbishment of the existing Victorian terraced house in Clapham. This is just one of the many advantages stable timber has over composite/WPC.

The cladding had two different width boards. The facing board was 130mm wide and the fin board was 90mm wide. These were put together as an L – shape with a small gap in between.
